OVERVIEW

The frigate Carlo Margottini is the third of the European Multi Mission Frigates (so-called FREMM), and the second of the class in the ASW (Anti Submarine Warfare) version.

The ship was launched on 29 June 2013 by FINCANTIERI di Riva Trigoso and delivered to the Navy on 27 February 2014. With the delivery of the Combat flag - on 22 April 2016 in Reggio Calabria - the Margottini frigate officially became part of the ships frontline of the team.

Nave Margottini took part, in 2014, in the Mare Nostrum Operation; in February 2015 it participated in the Smart Hunt antisubmarine exercise, collaborating with the German Navy and in June 2016 the Unit participated in an activity of the Naval Squad with Units of the United States Navy, included in the Green Fleet, a project of an Italian initiative aimed at developing an alternative naval fuel to the fossil one to increase energy capacity and reduce polluting emissions.

In 7 of September 2020, ITS Margottini has been employed in Operation EUNAVFOR MED IRINI as its Flagship.
