Brigadier General Filippo QUAGLIATO (ITAF)

Brigadier General Filippo QUAGLIATO was born in Venice, on October 26th, 1972. He joined the Air Force Academy in 1991, attending the course "NIBBIO 4"in Pozzuoli (Naples) and graduating as a 2nd Lieutenant in 1995. In 1996 he obtained his Military Pilot Wings flying T-37 and T-38 at the Euro-NATO Joint Jet Pilot Training School of Sheppard Air Force Base (USA).

In 1996 he was assigned to the 30th Wing in Cagliari Elmas where he served as Commander of the 167th Flight of the 86nd Flying Squadron, participating in maritime patrolling, anti-submarine and reconnaissance operations in NATO mission over the Former Yugoslavia, Bosnia, Kosovo and Albania. In 1999 served in the Italian Air Force Academy as military instructor, dealing with Officers' recruitment and education.



In 2000 was assigned to the 31st Wing in Rome Ciampino where he commanded the 517th Flight first and then, with the rank of Major, served as Chief of the Crew Training Centre and as 306th Squadron Commander, carrying out VVIP State flights and hospital flights for the Italian Government.

In 2007 he served as the Herat FSB Deputy Commander for NATO International Security Assistance Force in Afghanistan.

He was promoted Colonel in 2010 and assigned to the Italian Airforce Staff, Air-Space Plan and Policy Division dealing with equipment and armed system Operational Requirements, planning and defining the forthcoming capabilities of the Air Force.

In 2015 he was appointed as 31st Wing Commander at Ciampino Roma Air Force Base, in charge of fulfilling the missions assigned to the Wing: to ensure State flights for the Italian Government, high readiness hospital flights for the national Ministry of Health and airlift requirements for the Italian Civil Protection Department.

After attending the Defence and Strategic Studies Course at the Beijing National Défense University in China, in 2018 he joined the Italian Defence General Staff, Policy and Planning Division as Head of Defence Capability Development.

In October 2020 he has been promoted Brigadier General as Operation EUNAVFOR MED Irini's Chief of Staff.

BG Quagliato has over 4500 flying hours on different aircrafts, with a broad operational experience manly on Falcon 50, Falcon 900 and Airbus 319 and attended numerous professional courses. BG Quagliato is a graduate in Aeronautical Sciences for Security and Defence from the University "Federico II" of Naples and he earned a Master of Political Sciences degree from the University of Trieste, a Master in International Military and Security Studies from the University "LUISS" of Rome and a Master in Military Science Strategic Studies from the National Defence University of Beijing.

Brigadier General Filippo Quagliato enjoys reading, skiing and outdoor activities. He's married with Valentina and have two daughters, Federica and Veronica.
