












Operation EUNAVFOR MED IRINI

The Libyan peace process took place through a series of meetings, initiatives and actions aimed at resolving the long lasting Libyan Civil War. Among them, Berlin Conference on Libya held in January 2020 involved many actors, international and regional organisations and representatives of countries of the Mediterranean Basin, all committed to a peaceful solution to the Libyan conflict. One of the outcomes of the conference was the necessity to effectively implement the UN arms embargo on Libya.

In order to deliver this outcome, on 17 February 2020, the Foreign Affairs Council of the European Union decided to launch a new CSDP (Common Security and Defence Policy) Operation in the Mediterranean focused on the implementation of the United Nation Security Council Resolutions on the arms embargo on Libya, while closing Operation SOPHIA. The Operation, named EUNAVFOR MED IRINI - Greek for "peace" - was thus launched on 31 March 2020.

Its core task is the implementation of the UN arms embargo on Libya through the use of aerial, satellite and maritime assets.

In detail EUNAVFOR MED IRINI is mandated to carry out inspections of vessels on the high seas off the coast of Libya suspected to be carrying arms or related material to and from Libya in accordance with United Nations Security Council Resolution 2292 (2016) in addition to monitoring violations perpetrated via aerial and land routes.

As secondary tasks, the Operation also monitors and gathers information on illicit exports from Libya of petroleum, crude oil and refined petroleum products; it contributes to the capacity building and training of the Libyan Coast Guard and Navy; it contributes to the disruption of the business model of human smuggling and trafficking networks through information gathering and patrolling by planes.

IRINI is led by Rear Admiral Stefano TURCHETTO as EU Operation Commander and its headquarters is located in Rome, Italy.

Launched on 31 March 2020, the mandate of Operation IRINI was extended up to 31 March 2023 and is under the close scrutiny of EU Member States, that exercise the political control and strategic direction through the Political and Security Committee (PSC).




