OVERVIEW

Patrol boat Comandante Foscari was launched on November 24, 2000, started sea trials on May 2002, was delivered to the Italian Navy on August 2 the same year; she has and become operative the following year.

ITS Comandante Foscari, as well as the other four units belonging to the “Comandanti” class, are named after former officers of the Italian Navy who were awarded the gold medal for military valor during World War II.

The motto of ITS Comandante Foscari “Idem animus eadem voluntas” (Courage equals strong will), is the same as for Fighting ship “Brin”(delivered to the King’s Navy in 1905), and Destroyer “Fuciliere,” active during WWII.
