OVERVIEW

HS Kanaris is a series of famous naval vessels of the Hellenic Navy named in honour of Admiral and statesman Konstantinos Kanaris, a hero of the Greek War of Indipendence.

Nowaday Kanaris is an Elli-class missile frigate currently in active service. It can accomodate approximately 170-190 personnel. It is equipped with a flight deck and hangar capable of accomodating ad refueling helicopters. HS Kanaris is a multi-role vessel designed primarily for sea control and air sea defence.

It participates in NATO, EU and UN International missions, such as global maritime security operations, counterterrorism escort, and anti-smuggling patrols in Mediterranean. It also performs search and rescue (SAR) tasks on the high seas and surveillance of national and European maritime borders.
